FUJI's FRENIC-EcoPAK series meets American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 requirement (ARRA, Pub. L. 115-5).

The American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (Pub. L. 111-4) is an economic stimulus package enacted by the 111th United States Congress in February 2009. This act was signed into law by President Obama mainly intended to provide a stimulus to the U.S. economy in the wake of the economic downturn. The nominal estimate measure of this act is worth \$787 billion, including domestic spending in education, healthcare, and infrastructures. This act also includes numerous non-economic recovery related items and establishes a "Buy American" requirement for federal, states, and local government projects funded with ARRA stimulus package.
